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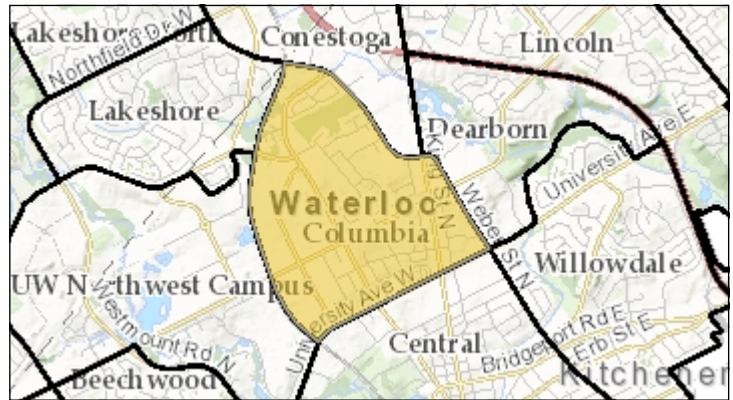

2011 Census Data

“Census” refers to Statistics Canada’s Census of Population which collects demographic, population and dwelling information on every person living in Canada. All Canadians are required to complete a Census form i.e. it is not voluntary. Therefore the Census data is based on a 100% sample of the population. The Census occurs every 5 years.

Due to the voluntary nature of the National Household Survey (NHS), a Global Non-response Rate (GNR) is used as an indicator of data quality. As such, a higher GNR results in a higher non-response bias and as a result lower data quality and vice versa. The 2011 GNR for the City of Waterloo was 22.4%, however, it varies for the various planning districts. Due to its voluntary nature, City staff have concerns with the reliability and representativeness of the NHS data at the Planning District level of geography. Therefore, the decision has been made not to include the NHS data for the various planning districts. Please note that due to differences in methodologies, between the NHS and past censuses, direct comparisons should not be made between the data.

Additional Information

“Census” refers to Statistics Canada’s Census of Population which collects demographic, population and dwelling information on every person living in Canada. All Canadians are required to complete a Census form i.e. it is not voluntary. Therefore the Census data is based on a 100% sample of the population. The census occurs every 5 years.

In 2011, the National Household Survey (NHS) replaced the mandatory long-form census questionnaire. Due to the voluntary nature of the NHS, a Global Non-response Rate (GNR) is used as an indicator of data quality. As such, a higher GNR results in a higher non-response bias and as a result lower data quality and vice versa. The 2011 GNR for the City of Waterloo was 22.4%, however, it varies for each Planning District. Due to its voluntary nature, City staff have concerns with the reliability and representativeness of the NHS data at the Planning District level of geography. Therefore, the decision has been made not to include the NHS data for the various planning districts. Please note that due to differences in methodologies between the NHS and past censuses, direct comparisons should not be made between the data.

The NHS data does not include those living in collective dwellings (e.g. nursing homes, group homes).

The Statistics Canada census data does not include non-resident post-secondary students and other foreign/temporary residents.

The Statistics Canada Planning District boundaries do not necessarily match the City of Waterloo’s District Plan boundaries, nor do all of the Planning Districts have a corresponding statistical profile.

In some cases due to a low response rate, Statistics Canada has suppressed data, or, for example, where a geographic area had a GNR greater than or equal to 50%. Statistics Canada data is subject to rounding for the purposes of confidentiality. Therefore, some totals may not be exactly the same as the sum of the values shown, especially when comparisons are made between tables.
